#### RULES

1. All llamas must have a halter on at all times while on the fairgrounds.
2. All *out of state* llamas must be accompanied by a health certificate issued within **30** days of the final day of the event. Exam must include inspection for spinus ear ticks.
3. All exhibitors are required to pay a stall fee of \$30.00 per stall (**Limit** of 3 llamas per stall) and a \$20.00 entry fee for every class in which each animal is entered.
4. Exhibitors are responsible for ALSA, & other local and state rules that govern this fair.
5. This is an ALSA Sanctioned Show. In accordance with ALSA rules, any exhibitor who is not an ALSA member must pay a \$30.00 fee at check in time.
6. All breeding llamas 13 months and older entered in approved classes, with the exception of youth classes, must be registered or have passed screening with the International Llama Registry (ILR) or the Canadian Livestock Record Corporation (CLRC). Non-Breeder llamas do not have to be registered or have passed screening with the ILR or the CLRC except those recorded with ALSA and participating in the Award System. Breeding llamas entered in the 5 months through 12 months age sections must be registered and present papers. **Copies of registration papers must be sent in with entry form.**
7. Exhibitors must be registered owners and make entries in the exact names (owner & llama) as shown on the registration certificate. Exhibitors may or may not be handlers.
8. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners compete for grand and reserve grand champion classes.
9. All animals entering the show must compete (show) in at least one class or may be asked to leave the Fairgrounds.
10. Age for juniors will be determined as follows: 8 years old shall be determined as of individuals birthday. 9 years & up shall be determined as of January 1.
11. Exhibitors must have registration certificates to show (even juveniles). A pending certificate will be accepted with entries, however animal must be registered and have original registration papers by showtime.

12. Unruly animals must be dismissed from the ring by the judge when the animal is a safety threat.
13. Fair will not provide bedding. Straw only, no shavings allowed.
