RULES

- A. Farm space will be assigned by fair staff.
- B. Entries shall be accepted from Sonoma County families. All products entered in the One Family Farm must have been produced within the county during the past year by the exhibitor or members of the family on land farmed by the exhibitor. Products entered as part of the exhibit will not be eligible for competition for individual product premiums.
- C. No minimum or maximum of ag commodities but please provide small signs to identify products.
- D. Exhibitor must provide their own fencing around front of garden, or around any area where garden faces public.
- E. Exhibitor may include a family farm sign or other identification if so desired, after judging.
- F. Any straw or like materials must be provided by exhibitor and be fireproofed.
- G. Any fresh picked plant material must be in water.
- H. No photographs will be allowed in exhibit until judging has been completed.
- I. **NOTE:** Harvest Fair not responsible for exhibits not picked up by release dates.

RULES

- A. Farm space will be assigned by the Fair Staff.
- B. Entries open to Sonoma County Commercial, Wholesale or Retail Businesses, including Farm Market Members. All farm products must be produced in Sonoma County (props exempt).
- C. Size of exhibit space varies according to the soil-filled raised beds (220 –260 square feet). Height is restricted to 8 feet.
- D. Exhibitor may include a business name sign or other identification if so desired after completion of judging. **Exhibitor has the option of selling farm products from the farm feature (approval must be obtained from fair office).**
- E. No minimum or maximum number of products to be displayed, however all must be for sale through your business operation.
- F. All products used must be labeled as to variety and kind.
- G. Fencing must be in place to keep public out of feature.
