



You Can Be A Harvest Fair Volunteer

The Harvest Fair is just around the corner (October 2, 3 & 4) and we are hoping that you will join us as a Special Events volunteer. Special Events is responsible for all the fun stuff at the Harvest Fair. We want to have as many “hands on” activities as possible, but our major stumbling block has always been supervision. The more helping hands we have, the more activities.

Who Can Volunteer? We ask that all volunteers be at least 14 years old and in good health—you may end up standing most of your shift!

What will you be doing? There are an assortment of “activity centers”, all of which require supervision. These include the Barnyard Scramble (a barnyard obstacle course), a Halloween Art Project, The Building Zone (legos, zoob), Sticker Art, Pumpkin Bowling and more. In all cases, we will have everything you need and complete instructions waiting for you. You will probably be working with someone who has done this before.

When will you be working? The Fair opens at 10 a.m.,. Most activity centers open by 11 a.m. and stay open until 6 p.m. Volunteers will work one (or more) of the three shifts during the day. The more volunteers on these days, the more activities! On Friday, we're expecting school groups, so we're starting a little earlier.

What do you get? Aside from what I hope will be a good time, you will get an official Harvest Fair worker shirt, passes to get in the gate and park, and a commemorative poster.
